The Centers for Disease Control CDC suggests that anyone who is 9 months Yellow Fever through 59 years old and traveling to or living in an area where the risk of yellow fever is present should be vaccinated. Requiring the certificate of vaccination from travellers is at the discretion of each State Party, and it is not currently required by all countries.
