Almost a three star effort; it is written well enough, and covers both the evidence for the legend and the ongoing controversy over its veracity exhaustively. We're guided through various medieval chronicles and later Protestant polemicsthe societal context of the age in which she supposedly lived, and various literary treatments over the centuries. I appreciate Stanford's more scholarly approach than the novel "Pope Joan" by Donna Woolfolk Cross, and I appreciate the more journalistic searching than I saw in Emmanuel Rhoides book.

It is also an investigation of the role of women in the church and in Western society. I always thought the story of Pope Joan was a myth, largely because it seemed too impossible to be true - that a woman could fool the entire Vatican hierarchy, even back in the ninth century, and become Pope, only to be discovered when she became pregnant and gave birth.
